Since 2009 we have trained over 1,000 women how to climb trees and 10% of participants have continued their journey to work professionally in the field of Arboriculture.

WTCW has grown into a genuine workforce development program. Proudly we have witnessed the impact on how the Women's Tree Climbing Workshop™ continues to transform the face of Arboriculture. We build career path opportunities and develop continuing education for new and existing arborists.

After 12 years, we implemented an Executive Director position to expand WTCW's capacity. Excited for 2022, we are planning six workshops and will offer new programming later this year.

Our first workshop in 2022 is scheduled for April 22-24 as we collaborate again with the Texas Chapter of the ISA. In May, we'll return to Camp Hi-Rock, a gorgeous and remote YMCA camp in Western Massachusetts. Other locations include North Carolina, Colorado with the Rocky Mountain Chapter of ISA, Minnesota with the MN Chapter of ISA; and back to Camp Hi-Rock again in the Fall.
